Rules and Regulations

FINE ARTS EVENTS

SKETCHING

- This is a solo event.
- · Participants shall bring their own stationery.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- · Paper will be provided.
- Theme: Cityscapes

MEHENDI COMPETITION

- This is a solo event.
- · Participants shall bring their own materials.
- Mehendi to be applied on one hand up to elbow, both sides.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Participants can apply mehendi on their own hand or bring along a model.

RANGOLI

- This is a solo event.
- Theme: Geometric Patterns
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- · Participants shall bring their own materials.
- Only rangoli colours to be used.
- Dimension: 24" X 24 "

CANVAS PAINTING

- This is a solo event.
- Participants shall bring own materials.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Canvas size: 12" X 16" (medium)
- Theme: Landscapes
- Type of paint any

TATTOO MAKING

- This is a solo event.
- · Participants shall bring their own materials and tools.
- Tattoo (temporary) to be made on forearm only.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Participants can work on their own forearm or bring along a model.
- No obscenity to be tattooed.

BRIDAL MAKE-UP

- This is a solo event.
- Bridal make up includes face make-up, hair style and costume draping.
- · Participants shall bring their own materials.
- · Participants should bring along a model.
- · Reference materials will not be permitted.
- All make-up, hair styling and costume draping must be done on the spot by the competing artist single handed. No helper allowed.

JEWELLERY MAKING

- This is a solo event.
- Participants shall bring their own materials and tools.
- Only one item to be made.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Jewelry type any

NAIL ART

- This is a solo event.
- · Participants shall bring their own materials and tools.
- · Artificial nails are allowed.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Participants must work on only one hand.
- Participants can work on their own nails or bring along a model.

CALLIGRAPHY

- This is a solo event.
- Participants shall bring their own stationery.
- Paper will be provided.
- Use of colours NOT allowed. Only black ink to be used.

COOKING WITHOUT FIRE

- · This is a solo event.
- Participants should bring their own materials.
- All chopping and preparation to be done at venue only.
- Reference materials will not be permitted.
- Recipe card (name, ingredients, method of preparation typed on A4 size paper) is compulsory.

PERFORMING ARTS EVENTS

STREET PLAY

- · This is a team event.
- Number of participants: 7 to 10
- Time limit: 10 minutes
- Theme: Any
- Language: English, Hindi or Marathi.
- Copy of the script must be submitted to the in-charge teacher before the performance.
- 1 minute will be given for stage setting and 1 minute for clearance. Each team must vacate the stage according to the time allotted.
- No discourteous words, obscenity and offensive gestures to be used.

GROUP DANCE

- This is a team event.
- Number of participants: 5 to 10
- Time limit: 5 minutes
- Props are allowed.
- Indecent costumes and gestures are forbidden.
- Any kind of powder/ sparkles/ flowers or similar materials SHOULD NOT be scattered on the stage.

SOLO DANCE

- This is a solo event.
- Time limit: 3 minutes
- · Indecent costumes and gestures are forbidden.
- Props are allowed.
- Any kind of powder/ sparkles/ flowers or similar materials SHOULD NOT be scattered on the stage.

SOLO SINGING

- This is a solo event.
- Time limit: 3 minutes
- Karaoke is allowed.
- · Musical instruments are not allowed.
- Music on mobile phone will not be played.
- Language English, Hindi or Marathi
- No discourteous lyrics, obscenity and offensive gestures to be used during the performance.

DUET SINGING

- Participation in pair.
- Language: English, Hindi or Marathi
- · Time limit: 4 minutes
- · Karaoke is allowed.
- Musical instruments are not allowed.
- Music on mobile phone will not be played.
- No discourteous lyrics, obscenity and offensive gestures to be used during the performance.

PERSONALITY CONTEST (MR. & MISS APRATIM)

- This is a solo event, participation of one boy and one girl from each college is compulsory.
- Participants must fill the separate form provided for registration.
- There will be a preliminary round and a final round.
- In the preliminary round, contestants will be judged on presentation skills, communication skills, body language, and creative skills.
- Each contestant will be given 2 minutes to showcase his/her talent (any performance).
- Area of performance can be singing, dancing, acting, or any creative display of talent.
- College will not provide any material required for showcasing your talents.
- Based on performance in the preliminary round, contestants will qualify for the final round.
- In the final round, contestants will be judged based on a question-and-answer session and overall presentation.
- Participants in objectionable attire will not be allowed to participate.

LITERARY ARTS EVENTS

DEBATE

- · This is a team event of two members.
- Language English.
- · Team must prepare (both, For and Against) on any one topic.
- Decision on who will talk For and Against will be done on the spot.
- Each member can speak for maximum 5 minutes.
- · Topics: i. Does technology make us less intelligent?
 - ii. Social Media has improved human communication.
 - iii. Should sale of human organs be legalized?

QUIZ

- · This is a team event of 2 members.
- A pair in a team should be from the same junior college.
- General knowledge & current affairs-based questions will be asked.
- Elimination round may happen depending on the number of teams participating.
- Rules of the event will be explained at the venue on the day of the event.

GENERAL RULES

- College identity card and registration form (with Principal's sign and college stamp) are mandatory at the entrance.
- Two entries per college are permitted for all Solo or Duet (pair) events. For group events, only one entry is permitted.
- Registration is compulsory for all events, to be done latest by 30th September 2024.
- Spot entries will be taken depending on the total number of participants in the event.
- Participants should report at the registration desk one hour before the commencement of their respective event.
- Soundtrack/ karaoke should be saved in a pen drive and must be submitted at the registration desk on the day of the event.
- For Fine Arts Events:
 - · Reference materials will not be permitted.
 - All work should be done at the venue.
 - All fine arts events have time limit of 1 hour, except Bridal make-up competition with limit of 1½ hour.
- · Participants violating the rules will be disqualified.
- · Decision by the jury and organizers will be final and binding.
- Do not bring valuable possessions, college would not take responsibility in case of loss or theft.
- Indiscipline and disrupting institution's decorum may attract appropriate actions from authorities.
