- Team event

- Branding and Strong tagline should be given.
- Note: Judges/audience can ask 1–2 quick questions.
- 3d model or prototype of your product, can be used along with ppt.

- Solo event
- The theme can be chosen by the participant.

- Submission of PPT must be done half an hour before the event, at the venue.
- Language – English/ Hindi
- Questions may be asked by the judges.

- Solo event.
- Participants have to select a villainous character from a novel or a play.
- The participant will have to justify the actions of this villainous character from the perspective of the villain, describing their deeds in a manner that highlights their motivations and beliefs.
- Participants will be given 3 minutes to present his/her points.
- Language: English/Hindi
- Participants must dress up as the villainous character whose actions they are justifying.
- Participants are encouraged to come in their costumes from home.
- Time: 1:00p.m.
- Venue: 6th floor, AV room
- Special Instructions:
Kindly stick to the plot of the story from which the character is chosen.
Kindly refrain from mentioning any individual; expressing religious/ political beliefs, using any obscene words/ slang/ objectionable content as this will lead to immediate disqualification.

PERSONALITY SHOWDOWN

Round 1: Introduction Round

- Participants introduce themselves in 1 minute.
- Content, clarity, and confidence are judged.
- Language: English Hindi & Marathi.

Round 2: Talent Round

- Participants showcase any one talent (e.g., singing, dancing, mimicry, monologue, poetry, etc.).
- Time limit: 2 min.
- Props/music to be arranged in advance.
- Judged on creativity, originality, and presentation.

Round 3: Question-Answer Round

- Each participant will be asked 1question on-the-spot.
- Judged on spontaneity, presence of mind, and articulation.
- Time: 10:30 a.m.
- Venue: Ground floor, Auditorium

SOLO DANCE

- Duration: 3 mins.
- Indecent costumes and gestures are forbidden.
- Props are allowed.
- Any kind of flowers or powder are not allowed.
- Registration fee: 50/- per participant
- Time: 1:00p.m.
- Venue: Auditorium (Ground Floor)

GROUP DANCE

- Number of participants: 5 to 10
- Duration: 5mins.
- Props are allowed.
- Any kind of flowers or powder are not allowed.
- Indecent costumes and gestures are forbidden.
- Registration fee: Rs. 100/- per group.
- Time: 1:00 p.m.
- Venue: Auditorium (Ground Floor)

GENERAL RULES

- College identity card is mandatory at the entrance.
- Registration is compulsory for all events latest by 5th October, 2025.
- Spot entries will be taken depending on the total number of participants in the event.
- Singing and Dance participants should report at the registration desk one hour before the commencement of their respective event.
- For other events, participants will report half an hour before the time of the event.
- Participants must carry college letter with college seal and Principal's sign, mentioning names of all the participants and their events.
- Registration fee to be deposited in cash at the registration desk (applicable for few events only as mentioned in the rules above).
- Soundtrack/ karaoke should be saved in a pen drive and has to be submitted at the registration desk on the day of the event.
- For Fine Arts Events:
 - Reference materials will not be permitted.
 - All work should be done at the venue.
 - Participant violating the rules will be disqualified.
- The decision by the jury and organizers will be final and binding on all.
