### 11th Standard Online Admission Process Year 2026-27

For the students participating in the 11th Standard Centralized Online Admission Process for the academic session 2026-27:

- The facility to fill out Part-1 of the admission application was provided starting from April 10, 2026, until the declaration of the 10th Standard results by the State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune.
- Between 10/04/2026 and 08/05/2026, a total of 7,74,918 students registered by completing Part-1 of the admission application.
- The 10th Standard results were declared on 08/05/2026.
- Starting May 11, 2026, the facility for students to register for 11th Standard admission by filling out Part-1 and Part-2 of the online admission process has been made available on the official portal: <https://mahafyjadmissions.in>.

In this process, three regular rounds, an "Open to All" fourth round, and a special fifth round for girls are being conducted. Accordingly, students are appealed to register online for their admission as per the information and instructions available on the said portal.

The schedule for the Zero Round and Regular CAP Round 1 of the 11th Standard Centralized Online Admission Process for the academic session 2026-27 is submitted herewith. Information and instructions regarding the 11th Standard admission process will be published on the admission process website from time to time. Students/parents, as well as Principals of Junior Colleges, should take note of this. It is requested that this matter be given wide publicity.
