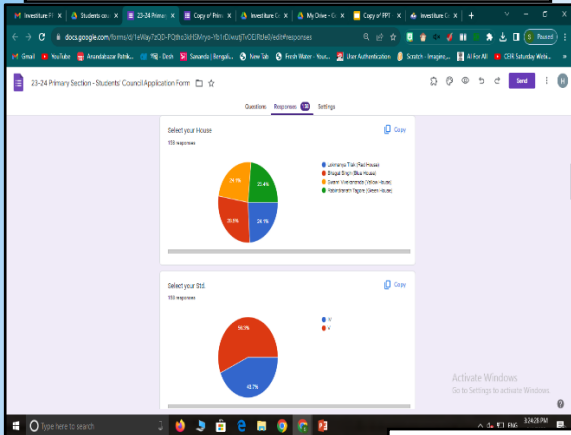

STUDENTS' COUNCIL SELECTION PROCESS

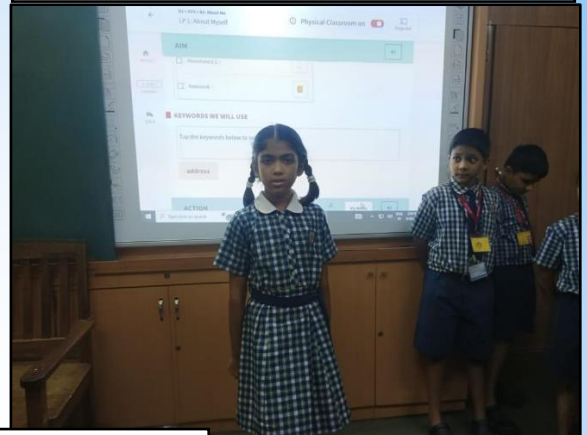
Primary Section

STUDENTS' COUNCIL SELECTION PROCESS

Secondary Section

In Round 1 - **Form Filling**, interested students from std VIII and IX nominated themselves by filling the details in the Google form.

Round 2 - **Ideation** which was conducted on 21st for Std VIII and 23rd for Std IX consisted of them presenting ideas for one sports and one co-curricular event. The ideas were judged based on creativity, originality and cost effectiveness.


Round 3 - **Behavioural Case Studies** was held on 30th June. For this round, candidates were given two case studies that dealt with behaviour of self and others. They presented their action plan to the judges which consisted of a counsellor and a discipline committee member.

Round 4 - **Interview** was held from 3rd - 6th July for selected candidates of the Students' Council. The interview was taken by heads and external judges. The candidates were quizzed on their knowledge of the school and their reason for contesting a certain post.

On 7th July, Candidates elaborated on why they were contesting for a particular post, what qualified them for that post, what would be their initiatives and how they would achieve it.

Round 5 – **Voting** involved casting of votes by students and teachers for their desired candidates on 10th July. Voting was done using the medium of Google Forms on multiple devices to cast votes.

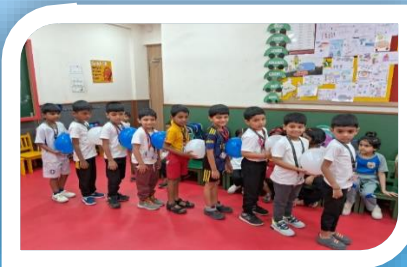
